# Golden Treasures Rescue ADOPTION APPLICATION

## **ABOUT THE ADOPTION PROCESS**

Thank you for your interest in adopting a rescued Golden Retriever from Golden Treasures. Our application process is designed to match the attributes and personality of our rescued Goldens to the home best-suited to each dog. If you are able to provide the special home that a rescued Golden deserves, we hope to be able to match you with the right dog, with attributes and personalities that are best suited to your home. Once your application is received, our volunteers do a vet check. If that is satisfactory, your application is assigned to a volunteer for interview. Once an application is approved, we arrange for a home visit. If we match you with a dog, you will be put in contact with the foster home to talk in more detail about that dog. If, after speaking with the foster home, you both agree this is a good match, then a meet and greet is set up. A decision is made after all these steps are taken. The completion of this form does not guarantee adoption of a dog from GT. Please allow 2-3 weeks for processing. If you have questions, contact us at info@Goldentreasuresrescue.org.

## **OUT OF STATE ADOPTION POLICY**

We do out-of-state adoptions within a reasonable distance, as long as the entire family (children and dogs included) is willing to drive here for a meet and greet. After an adoption takes place, and the dog is returned at any time for any reason, the adopter must DRIVE the dog back to us.

### THINGS TO CONSIDER BEFORE ADOPTION

 Good dog care in our area can cost \$1,200 annually. This includes annual vet care, inoculations, parasite testing, monthly heartworm and flea preventative, quality dog food, toys, miscellaneous equipment, boarding/kennel fees, grooming and other supplies. This does not include any injuries or illnesses the dog may incur.

• The dogs available for adoption are contingent upon those relinquished to us, so there is an on-going ebb and flow of dogs in our program. If you decided to purchase a Golden puppy instead, please visit www.GRCA.org for a list of reputable breeders.

If I adopt a dog from Golden Treasures, it will reside in my home as a pet. I will provide it with adequate shelter, food, water, training, affection and medical care, including monthly heartworm preventatives.

I understand that I must consent to an interview and a home visit before approval to adopt a Golden Treasures dog is granted. Reference checks may also be required.

I understand and agree that Golden Treasures may refuse my application for any reason, at its sole discretion. <u>I also understand that Golden Treasures may not disclose the reason for not approving my application, in order to maintain the privacy of both myself and the Golden Treasures volunteers.</u>

I understand that upon completing an adoption, I must sign a mutually acceptable Animal Adoption Contract, which shall be provided by Golden Treasures.
